



1. 前言

- a. 金曲忘不了歌唱大賽（以下簡稱「比賽」）由城市電視（以下簡稱「主辦機構」）主辦，比賽可以個人獨唱或組合形式參加（以下簡稱「參賽者」），參賽者必須選唱歌曲參賽。
- b. 評判團將依據下列各項作為對參賽者之評審標準：
 - i) 台風
 - ii) 音質
 - iii) 音樂感
 - iv) 技巧
- c. 主辦機構有權自行決定製作有關之電視節目及進行電視廣播。
- d. 參賽者同意遵守本表格內及可能會更改之一切申請條件及規則。

2. 參賽資格

- a. 參賽者之年齡、族裔不限。
- b. 參賽者必須是加拿大居民。
- c. 根據參賽者提供的資料，主辦機構有權豁免及放寬上述參賽條件。
- d. 參賽者必須不受任何合約束縛，以致不能簽署及履行主辦機構之合約，且未曾發行過任何的個人或非個人唱碟。
- e. 主辦機構城市電視或協辦機構新時代電視、加拿大中文電台及娛樂生活雜誌之僱員不可參加比賽，以示公允。

3. 參賽程序

- a. 參賽者必須填妥及簽署參加表格，同時在提交報名表格時，連同下列之文件及費用：
 - i) 參賽者之駕駛執照或護照或有效而附有照片的身份證明文件副本
 - ii) 一張半身照片
 - iii) 請編選 1 分 30 秒的伴唱純音樂，以展示個人演唱實力最精彩的歌曲段落。
 - 網上遞交表格時，請連同伴唱純音樂的檔案 (mp3/wav 格式) 一同上載；
 - 如親身遞交表格到新時代電視，請自備伴唱純音樂光碟 (USB 不適用) 於交表時一同呈上。
 - iv) 報名費用 (現金)
 - 一般報名 (四月十一日下午五時正或之前)：加幣三十元正
 - 即時現場報名 (四月十四日)：加幣四十元正

4. 比賽日期

- a. 初賽：二〇一九年四月十四日 (星期日)
- b. 總決賽：二〇一九年六月二十八日 (星期五)

參賽者必須出席所安排之各項活動，如未能遵守將被取消資格。

5. 同意聲明

- a. 參賽者明白及同意主辦機構有權隨時：
 - i) 拒絕任何申請而無須作出任何解釋。
 - ii) 挑選任何參賽者參加初賽。
 - iii) 全權決定參賽者所選唱歌曲。
 - iv) 全權決定參賽者的編號。
 - v) 取消參賽者之參賽資格而無須作出任何解釋。
 - vi) 更改、暫停或取消初賽及總決賽日期或地點，以及更改參賽規則及條例。
- b. 參賽者並同意
 - i) 主辦機構不用發還並擁有第三項所述之文件及報名費用。
 - ii) 對於參賽者的任何金錢或其他損失包括傷亡，無論是否由於主辦機構之疏忽或失誤引致，主辦機構無須負上任何責任或賠償。參賽者同意解除主辦機構對其所受之損失之一切責任。
 - iii) 參賽者必須服從大會評判團之決定，不得異議。
 - iv) 參賽者必須服從主辦機構對其髮型、化妝及服飾所作之安排。

1. Foreword

- a) The Unforgettable Classics Singing Contest (hereinafter the "Contest") is organized by Talentvision (hereinafter the "Organizer"). The Contest must participate by way of a solo or group performance (hereinafter the "Contestant"). The Contestant must select a song as his / her contesting song.
- b) The panel of judges will set its adjudicating standard based on the following criteria:
 - i) showmanship
 - ii) voice quality
 - iii) music sense
 - iv) technique
- c) The Organizer shall have the absolute right to decide upon and arrange television production and broadcast of the Contest.
- d) The Contestant agrees to be bound by and comply with these terms and regulations, as amended from time to time.

2. Qualifications of the Contestant

- a) Applicant from all age group and ethnic backgrounds are welcomed.
- b) The Contestant must be a resident of Canada.
- c) The Organizer shall have the right to waive or modify the above qualifications in relation to any Contestant.
- d) The Contestant shall not be bound by any legally binding agreement which will prevent or prohibit him/ her from entering into a performing agreement which may be entered into by the Contestant and the Organizer, and has never released any musical works of whatever nature.
- e) The Contestant must not be an employee of the Organizer Talentvision, and Co-organizers, Fairchild Television, Fairchild Radio and Popular Lifestyle & Entertainment.

3. Contesting procedures

- a) The Contestant shall complete and sign the application form, and must submit together with the following documents and fee:
 - i) a photocopy of the Contestant's driver's license, passport, or other valid picture identification;
 - ii) a photograph of the Contestant from the waist up;
 - iii) 1 minute and 30 sec edited MMO (pure music) in mp3 / wav format. The chosen duration should showcase your best vocal performance.
 - Online application: upload the MMO version of your audition song along with your application.
 - Application in person: submit an edited audio CD (not USB) with your application form.
 - iv) an application fee (Cash only) :
 - Regular (on or before April 11, 2019 at 5pm) : CAD \$30.00
 - Drop-in (April 14, 2019) : CAD \$40.00

- c) The deadline for regular application is April 11, 2019 at 5 pm.

4. Dates of various contests

- a. Audition: April 14, 2019 (Sunday)
- b. Final: June 28, 2019 (Friday)

The Contestant must attend all activities. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.

5. Declarations

- a) The Contestant understands and agrees that the Organizer has the absolute right at any time to:
 - i) refuse any application without explanation;
 - ii) select any Contestant to enter into the preliminary;
 - iii) choose and decide upon the contesting song of the Contestant;
 - iv) choose and decide upon the contesting numbers of the Contestant;
 - v) disqualify any Contestant without explanation;
 - vi) amend, suspend or cancel the dates and venues of the Auditions and the Final and to amend these terms and regulations without notice.
- b) The Contestant further agrees:
 - i) that the Organizer need not return and can retain the documents and application fee described in clause 3 or any other documents provided by the Contestant;
 - ii) that the Organizer need not compensate and shall in no way be liable for any monetary or other loss of the Contestant including but not limited to personal and fatal injuries, regardless of whether such loss arises in whole or in part as the result of the negligence or other wrongdoing of the Organizer and the Contestant expressly releases the Organizer from any and all such liability;
 - iii) to be bound by the decision of the Organizer and the panel of judges;
 - iv) to be bound by the decision of the Organizer in relation to the hair-style, make-up and costume of the Contestant;
 - v) to participate in the promotional activities arranged by the Organizer and to obey the reasonable and lawful directions of the Organizer pursuant to such promotional activities;
 - vi) the Organizer shall have the right to collect, use and disclose the Contestant's personal information for purposes of or related in any way to the promotion and production of the Contest.
 - vii) all proprietary rights in relation to any audition, performer or other product of the Contestant in relation to the Contest will vest solely in the Organizer.
 - viii) that all Final Contestants are required to enter into a one year management contract with Fairchild Television Ltd.

6. Confirmation

The Contestant confirms that the information given in this application form is true and correct. No images or other documents provided by the Contestant are or may be subject to third party copyright or any other third party legal or moral rights or claims. The Organizer will not be responsible for any lost, stolen, damaged, misdirected or destroyed application forms or other documents or for any human or technical errors in the processing thereof.

The Contest is governed by the laws of British Columbia and the laws of Canada applicable in British Columbia.

7. Language
